Locksmithing II: Doors & Hardware

Students completing this custom 5-day course will further develop their locksmithing skillset by exploring intermediate and advanced topics related to lock prep and installation, service, and key making.

While intended for students with previous experience, the start of the class will provide a short review of fundamentals before introducing more advanced topics. Students will then complete the week having done fresh installations of door closers, rim exit devices (panic bars), and related door hardware. Further, students will be given hands-on practice with a variety of service techniques such as latch and hinge adjustment.

Who Should Attend:

Those interested in learning the proper technique of installing frames, hanging doors and the hardware associated with the door. Professions such as locksmiths, facility managers, carpenters, and general and remodeling contractors.

Objectives:

- Review Terminology and Hardware Specifications
- Review Exit Devices and Door Closers
- Install Knock-down door frame, rim exit devices, and door closers
- Install Mortise Lock
- Hands-on exercise with coring doors
- Install electrified hinges and electric strikes
- Review and install other door hardware, such as, kick plates, weather stripping, and door thresholds
