

Government Safe Locks: Legacy to Present

There are many locks that have been approved for the storage of classified and sensitive information - past and present. How do you know which lock to use in a particular situation?

This course is designed to give each student a hands-on knowledge of those locks used by the US government for the protection of classified and sensitive information, arms, ammunition, and explosives. It includes legacy locks used by the government from the 1990's to present. The course will cover installation through disassembly and re-assembly, operation of the lock, including changing combinations and troubleshooting of the lock.
